# WHAT'S A TOWABLE ATTENUATOR?

This device can be also considered a TMA means Truck (or Trailer) Mounted Attenuator and is considered an impact attenuator to cushion the impact of vehicles in case of collision or accidents.

Its purpose is absorb and protect the vehicle in case of impact, absorbing the kinetic energy and returning it to the center of the crash, reducing damages.

Ideal to temporary place on work areas, diversions, detours, closed avenues, conflict zones or to be towed by a vehicle.

#### **FEATURES**

- Safety trailer manufactured in integral structure of 10-gauge (3.4 mm), 2½ x 2½ RHS.
- · Impact attenuator.
- Axle to withstand 3,500 lbs. (1,587.6 kg).
- · Two rims of 15" tire track with 5 lug nuts.
- Two 700-15 (15 rim) trailer tires.
- · Four leaf double eye spring.
- Striped energy absorber (bumper) reinforced and made of medium density polyethylene.
- Two side marker (indicator) lights for stop and reverse.
- 10-gauge (3.4 mm) RHS supports of 2½ x 2½ on the sides.
- Trailer coupler, 2 5/16" welded chassis for tow hitch that withstands 5,000 lbs. (2,268 kg) and a security chain
- Powered trough alternating current of the towing vehicle.
- · It includes a screw jack for better maneuverability.






- 1. Male cable connector outlet.

- 4.Security chain.
- 5. Shock absorber.
- 6.Screw jack.
- 7. Side marker (indicator) lights.
- 8. Rear lights.
- 9. Polyethylene energy absorber (bumper).
- 10. RHS supports.
- 11. Reflective stripes in energy absorber (bumper).


**Note:** electric power supply of the shock absorber is directly taken from the towing vehicle.
